1.Introduction

The Trustees of Dr.Gordon Memorial Trust, Thanjavur are pleased to present their annual reports of activities for the period from April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024.Dr. Gordon Memorial Trust is dedicated to building a healthier, more inclusive, and sustainable society that empowers individuals and ensures a dignified life for all.

2. Economical Sustenance to Women in the rural and urban poor areas

Dr.Gordon Memorial Trust is supporting women and their economic needs so that they could invest in their economic activities and make regular income to their families without falling into the trap of money lenders and their exploitation.

Women federation members met once in a month to collect and distribute seed money to the women in need and support her economic activities. During the year 12 women were supported to do their income generation activities. The meetings were held on April 15, 2023, May 16, 2023, June 17 2023, July 17 2023, August 17 2023, September 172023, October 19 2023, November 16 2023, December 18 2023, January 82024, February 19 2024 and March 20 2024.

5.Breast Feeding Week 2023

Dr. Gordon Memorial Trust in order to take the importance of breast feeding, the health, growth of infants and the mothers were taken intensively in the target villages. On August 4, 2023, Dr. Gordon Memorial Trust, organized awareness campaign in Soorakottai village, Thanjavur district. 64 mothers (all lactating mothers) turned out at the program. It was question and answer sessions as the mothers posed questions and the facilitators answered them and also cleared their doubts on the breast feeding, facts and myths etc.





6.Gender equality and Equity 2023

Dr. Gordon Memorial Trust organized one day workshop on August 17, 2023 that dealt the gender , gender equality and gender equity among women and girls in Vilangudi village, Thiruvaiyaru block, Thanjavur district. It was clearly explained the 50% of the women being denied justice to them in families, nutrition, education, dresses, medical assistance, higher education, property in heritance, forced marriage, child , teen marriage, widowhood, denial of second marriage to widows, etc. The participants learnt that girls importance and giving

equal importance and support to both girls and boys. It was stressed that mothers have to rear the children as gender sensitive persons.

8. Visit to Anbulllam, Residential School for the Mentally Retarded Children, Thanjavur

9. Health, nutrition and Women health

Dr. Gordon Memorial Trust organized one day training at VadakkuVasal area of Thanjavur City, on Health, Nutrition, and Women's Health jointly with Marutham Trust. 55 women and young mothers took part and benefitted under the program. Dr. Mangaiyarkarasi District Health Educator (Retd), Mr. Veeramani trainer facilitated the one day training program. This one day training program was organized on March 13, 2024. Topics: Nutrition, communicable diseases, reproductive diseases and infections, STD, RTI, HIV, Noncommunicable diseases, viz. diabetes, blood pressure, obesity etc. These women are from low income and urban poor families.
